Eligibility for all classes can be found in the current BRC Handbook. Eligibility will be taken from the Friday before the qualifier. All competitors must be a member and be on the BRC Database by midday the Friday before the qualifier. Anyone failing to meet the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed.

HorseQuest are once again sponsoring the BRC Arena Eventing qualifiers and championships. HorseQuest is the UK's leading equestrian sales website. With over 450,000 monthly visits and 2 million page views.

This competition will run under BRC Rules, anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below:

All entrants must submit a pre-entry to BRC (fees can be found in the current BRC Handbook) at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier. Pre-entries can be made via the pre-entry website <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/login?referral=%2Fselect>. Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £10 per individual and £20 per team (payable to BRC HQ) if space permits. **Late entries cannot be guaranteed and so therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.**

Once the pre-entry has been made, an area entry must be made via the details outlined on this schedule.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason and rescheduled within 21 days, the close of pre-entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open. Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, regardless of rescheduling. Pre-entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the office in writing before the cut-off date which the area will be informed of upon rescheduling.

Hats

All hats must have a visible aqua BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground to show that they meet the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

Body Protectors

A body protector is obligatory in all cross-country competitions. Please see the current BRC Handbook for details on up to date standards. <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-rulebook>

Riders wearing Exo Body Cage protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

Flu Vaccinations & Microchips

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website. If you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518. As of 1 October 2020, it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and it is traceable.

Team Managers will receive a copy of their Club Vaccination database from the Official Steward. They will be required to check eligibility – full instructions will be received. Any new horses will need passports scanned and sent to the Official Steward for checking – this should be done by 20th September the only exception being late substitute horses.

Passports should travel with horses and there may be spot checks on the day.

- 4. Riders should bring their own number bibs complete with printed numbers.**
- 5. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, we will run on a minimum number of helpers. Please could each Club competing provide 1 or 2 full day helpers who will be required to bring their own refreshments. We will endeavour to let helpers know their times and tasks by Wednesday 23rd September so please ensure that you give us full contact details.**
- 6. For privacy reasons, please ask all of your riders whether they are happy to be photographed.**

CLOSE OF ENTRIES IS 10 days BEFORE THE EVENT AND HORSE & RIDER NAMES PLUS HELPERS INFORMATION SHOULD BE SENT TO THE SECRETARY BY THAT DATE.

PLEASE BE PROMPT WITH HORSE AND RIDER DETAILS SO THAT TIMES CAN BE PUBLISHED

THIS YEAR, WE WILL NEED TO LIMIT THE PEOPLE ATTENDING. PLEASE TELL YOUR RIDERS THAT THEY SHOULD ONLY BRING 1 HELPER PER HORSE – THEY SHOULD GIVE CONTACT DETAILS OF THAT PERSON AT TIME OF ENTRY AND ALSO ADVISE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF THEIR VEHICLE. NO DOGS PLEASE

THERE WILL BE NO PRIZE GIVING ON THE DAY TO ENSURE THAT RIDERS ARE PRESENT FOR THE MINIMUM LENGTH OF TIME. PROVISIONAL SCORES WILL BE PUT ON LINE AS SOON AS THEY ARE AVAILABLE AND ROSETTES WILL BE GIVEN TO LIAISON COMMITTEE REPS AT THE NEXT MEETING.
