**ENTRIES:**

**All entrants must make and pay for a pre-entry to the BRC AND an entry to the host club.**

All entrants must make and pay a pre-entry to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier. Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries [www.britishridingclubs.org.uk](http://www.britishridingclubs.org.uk) or online entries can be made via <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/login> . Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a

late surcharge, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought. Once a pre-entry has been made, an area entry must be made via the details outlined in this schedule. If the date of the qualifier is postponed for any reason, BRC rule G2.1.2 will apply.

Please use the BRC area entry form (available on the BRC website from 1<sup>st</sup> Sept) and make **cheques payable to Wellington Riding Club**, post to the above address (not to Wellington Riding!) along with the attached helpers form. Entries can also be made by email and I will contact you for bank transfer of entry fees.

**Declaration forms** may be submitted by email, no later than 5pm on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October. We will not be accepting declaration forms on the morning of the show. Declaration forms must be in the format sent to you by BRC.

### **Flu vaccines and microchips**

All horses must be up to date with influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC handbook. The most recent vaccination must be within 6 months and 21 days of the competition i.e. after 21/03/2020. As of 1<sup>st</sup> October it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped.

Team managers will receive a copy of their club's vaccination database from the Official Steward, and are responsible for checking eligibility. For new horses a scanned copy of the passport is to be submitted to the Official Steward. Passports must travel with horses and there may be spot checks on the day.

### **Rider Falls**

Please note that as there will not be paramedics in attendance, any rider who falls from a horse, anywhere on the showground, will not be allowed to remount. No refunds will be given in this situation.

**One helper must be provided for every team entered  
Vet on Call (Berkshire Equine), First aiders on site**

## RULES AND CONDITIONS

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Rule Book and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at this link: <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook>

**All hats must have a visible aqua BRC/PC/BE hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.**

1. The judge's decision is final.
2. No horses or ponies under 4 years of age may be ridden in any class or on the show ground
3. The organiser reserves the right to alter classes, cancel the show and refuse entry.
4. No entry will be accepted without the correct entry fee.
5. No entry fees will be refunded. Under BRC Rules, any Club entering a Team or Individual rider who does not ride on the day must relinquish their Prelim and Host entry fees. In the event of the qualifier being cancelled for reasons outside the organiser's control, a partial refund may be offered but any costs incurred must be covered by entry monies so this cannot be guaranteed.
6. Any complaints must be written out and handed to the Secretary of the Show within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a fee of £25, which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
7. All attendees are reminded that rudeness or bad behaviour will not be tolerated at our shows and events and if doing so, the person or persons may be asked to leave.
8. Please take your litter home. We are not allowed to leave any mess in the car park so please help us to keep the area clean and tidy. Please clear up after your horses.
9. We also wish to thank our Judges, sponsors and volunteers without whose invaluable help we would not be able to run this event.
10. Entries may be limited, in this case priority will be given to teams over individuals.
11. In the interests of health and safety, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and stewards, including in working in and viewing areas.
12. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers, land-owner and his agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, on-lookers, their property, servants or horses or ponies, how so ever caused and that each entrant agrees to indemnify them against any legal action arising there from.
13. Flash photography is strictly forbidden. Mobile telephones must be turned off during tests. Smoking is not permitted anywhere on site. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
